

**BUFFALO WATER BOARD NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF SCHEDULE OF RATES,  
FEES AND CHARGES**

**PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Buffalo Water Board, pursuant to the New York State Public Authorities Law, upon public notice previously published with the Buffalo City Clerk and the Buffalo News conducted a public hearing on September 10, 2025 commencing at 9:00 a.m. at Room 210 City Hall, 65 Niagara Square, Buffalo, New York, and simultaneously by remote video and audio access, provided the public an opportunity to be heard with respect to a proposal to amend the Buffalo Water Board's Schedule of Rates, Fees and Charges in connection with the use, construction, operation and maintenance of the Buffalo Water Board Water System. Upon due consideration of the comments presented by the persons in attendance at such public hearing, and upon the recommendation of the Buffalo Water Board's independent Rate Consultant and Consulting Engineer, immediately after such public hearing, the Buffalo Water Board conducted a public meeting, and with a quorum present throughout such meeting, the Buffalo Water Board adopted amendments to the Schedule of Rates, Fees and Charges, effective October 1, 2025, which increased all rates, fees and other charges, and, among other things, include: (1) Residential Consumer Affordable Water Program; (2) Continuation of Qualified Senior Citizen Discounted Rates; (3) Water Consumption Block Charge Increases; (4) Capacity and Infrastructure Charges Increases; (5) Fire Line Charge Increases; (6) Miscellaneous Charges Increases; and (7) Reference to Consumer Price Index for Future Rate Adjustments.
